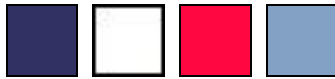

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DRESS CODE HIGHLIGHTS • 2011/2012

The information provided in this document does not represent the dress code in its entirety, rather it contains selected paragraphs to help students and parents prepare for the next school year. Detailed information about the dress code is contained in the Parent-Student Handbook.

Students may wear long- or short-sleeved dress shirts in white or light blue, and long- or short-sleeved polo shirts in red (not maroon), navy, or white. For the 2011/2012 school year the light blue polo shirt will be permitted, however we will be phasing that color of polo shirt out of the dress code for the 2012/2013 school year. Shirts must not contain any printing, logos or other designs. Any under shirts must be white and not visible (no long tails, too-long sleeves, etc.) Undergarments must not be visible.



There are enough options in our uniform selection that outerwear such as hooded sweatshirts (hoodies), long-sleeved t-shirts, and sweatshirts will not be permitted to be worn in the classroom if they are visible either over or under the uniform. The only exception to this are the sweaters identified in the dress code.

Dress pants, shorts, skirts, skorts, and jumpers identified in the dress code, in colors navy, khaki, or blue/red plaid, are permitted. The blue/gold plaid skirts may also be worn however the blue/gold plaid will be phased out of the dress code in the 2012/2013 school year. Skinny pants, colored denim, corduroy, loose- or tight-fitting clothing is not acceptable. Embellishments (embroidery, jewels, and excessive buckles) are not permitted.



All shoes should be conservative in style. Shoes should be plain or in coordinated colors of black, brown, navy or white. Modest stripes, patterns and multi-tone colored shoes are acceptable if they contain only the coordinated colors (black, brown, navy or white). Other colors are not acceptable. All shoes should be free of lights, 'characters' (e.g., Spiderman, Barbie, etc.), and/or glaring logos. Sandals, flip flops, and shoes without a back are not permitted. Boots are acceptable in plain black, brown and navy, provided they are worn under uniform pants. Ugg-style boots are not permitted. Any heels or platform shoes should be a safe height of no more than 1". Tennis shoes are acceptable and are subject to the same guidelines as all other shoes; modest stripes are okay, but bright colors are not acceptable. Any shoes which call attention to themselves through color, pattern, design, or in any other manner will not be allowed.

Students should wear coordinated sock colors in white, navy, brown or black. Socks may be ankle or knee length, and girls are permitted to wear tights in white or navy. Knit leggings or pants that are visible under skirts are not permitted.

Students must present a neat appearance. Shirts must be worn tucked in. Shoes should be tied and belts worn with belt-looped pants and shorts. Uniforms must not be over-sized or under-sized. Uniforms must be clean and in good repair.

Girls may wear small post earrings; no dangling or hoop-style earrings are allowed. Rings, necklaces, and bracelets, if worn, must be simple in appearance. Watches are allowed. No other items of jewelry or adornment are allowed.

Hair must be kept neat and have a combed appearance. Girls may wear their own plain, color-coordinated hair accessories in addition to those available from the uniform company. Irregular coloring of hair or outlandish hairstyles will be considered inappropriate. Hair coloring and outlandish hairstyle parameters are left to the discretion of the Administration.

No make-up, including press-on nails may be worn in grades K-5; in grades 6-7-8 no excessive make-up may be worn. Any make-up must be simple and neat (no outlandish colors are allowed). Clear or natural color polish is acceptable, but must not be brought to school to be applied.

No hats of any kind, including baseball caps may be worn in the building.
